Home # VS Mobile

Many employees have listed their mobile number as their home number.

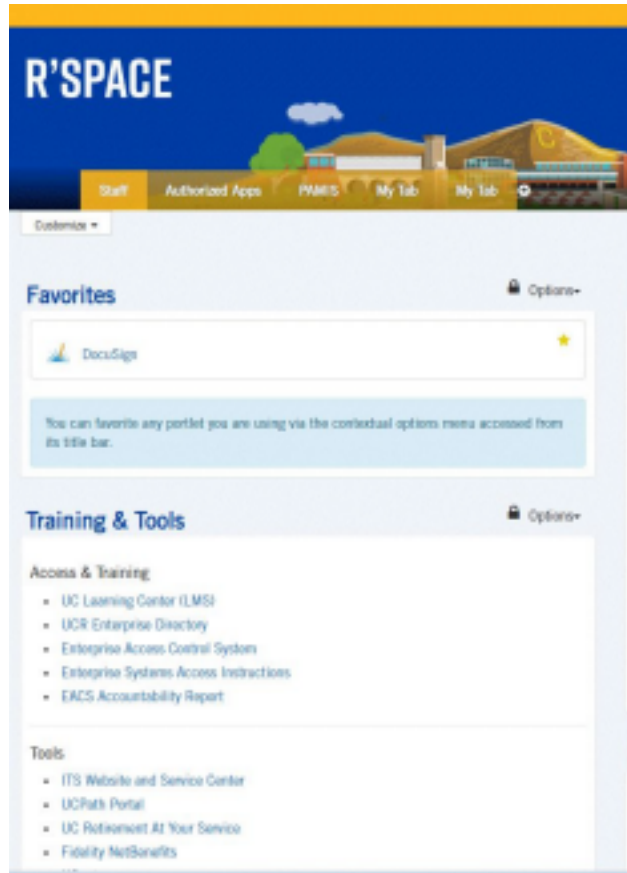
Unfortunately, the home number is captured as a landline so you will not receive a text message. You will receive a voice mail.

To ensure you receive a text message, you must enter your mobile number into

UC Path as a Mobile number.
